



Quaternary geological map of Loviisa, Finland

- Bedrock outcrop
- Bedrock, thin Quaternary surficial deposits on bedrock
- Cobbles and boulders
- Diamicton, usually till
- Coarse-grained sorted sediments (fine sand to gravel)
- Fine-grained sorted sediments, mainly silt
- Fine-grained sediment with low gyttja content (2-6%), mainly silt
- Clay
- Gyttja (nutrient-rich organic mud)
- Thick peat deposits, usually over 0,6 m
- Artificial (man-made) ground, land fill or unexplored area
- Water areas (lakes, large rivers or Baltic Sea)
